- Change your current benefit elections
- Add or remove covered dependents

- Review your current benefits in Workday.
- You'll have the opportunity to make Flexible Spending Account (FSA) and/or Health Savings Account (HSA) elections in October 2024 for the 2025 calendar year. Except for FSAs and the HSA, our benefit plans will still have a July 1 to June 30 plan year.
- If you are currently enrolled in the health care or limited purpose flexible spending accounts, your next opportunity to update your election will be in October for a January 2025 effective date.

You don't have to do anything to keep your current coverage. However, you MUST complete enrollment to:

- Change your current benefit elections
- Add or remove covered dependents
